

Items to Bring to YSAC09

- **ID, Student ID, Insurance Card (also passport and visa if required)**
- **Please bring Euros or CZK (Czech Crowns)! Your registration fee is due when you arrive.**
 - Registration fee schedule (includes all meals, lodging, and activities at the conference):**
 - € 55 for application before 15 June 2009
 - € 65 for application after 15 June 2009
 - € 50 for friends and investigators
 - € 165 for applicants from other areas who have a YSA conference in their area
- All clothing must be **modest*** (not sleeveless, cover the belly, etc.) in all weather (sunshine or rain)
 - *Be sure to read the ***For the Strength of Youth*** pamphlet*
- Sunday clothes for firesides
 - Men: dress pants (suit if you have one), white shirt, and tie
 - Women: nice dress, or skirt and blouse
- Colorful shirt or dress for Friday evening's party; a country hat if you have one for the Western Dance
- Sports clothing and shoes; **modest*** swim suit and towel
- (Old) clothes and shoes for the service project: painting, handling stones, trimming bushes, etc.
- Walking shoes, a rain coat, and a small back pack for your water and lunch for the service project
- Pajamas, underwear, socks, and laundry bag
- Antiperspirant/deodorant
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Hair brush/comb; hair drier if needed
- Toiletries: and all the special necessities for women; shaving utensils for men
- Flip-flops that can be used in the bathroom
- Any **medications** you need
- Tick and mosquito repellent, sunscreen, sun hat, sunglasses
- Band aids, kleenex, sewing kit
- Scriptures, notebook, pen, diary
- Camera if desired; pocket money for food or water for your travel
- Consecrated oil for Melchizedek Priesthood holders
- Do NOT bring bedding: pillows, mattresses, sheets, blankets, sleeping bags, tents, etc.
